OUR PROGRAM

We believe that children learn best in a loving and safe atmosphere. We provide a caring and encouraging environment that equally develops the mind, body, and soul. Our goal is for each child to develop a knowledge and relationship with God, as well as relationships with peers and adults.

We strive for children to develop independence in learning by introducing a variety of classroom and real life experiences in art, music, health, fitness & nutrition, cooking, etiquette & good manners, math, science, social studies, computers, American Sign Language and foreign languages. Each child is exposed to writing, reading, drama, creative movement, dance, puppetry along with in-school presentations and many hands-on field trips in the community and throughout the island. Our goal is to provide children with the tools necessary to begin kindergarten and to ultimately love school and as a result be a life-long learner!

Wai'alae Baptist Preschool is licensed by the State of Hawaii Department of Human Services to care for 49 children from over two to under six years old.

PROGRAM HOURS

Our year-round preschool is open Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., August to July. We are closed on all federal and state holidays and times as specified on the preschool calendar, which is provided before the school year begins.

PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

Your child must be two years old prior to being enrolled in our class for two year olds. It is not required for your child to be completely toilet trained before entering the 2/3 year old class. Children entering the 3/4 year old class, and 4/5 year old pre-kindergarten class must be toilet trained.

Kindergarten is required in Hawaii. Act 76 (2014) states that your child must be five years of age on or before July 31 of the school year to enter kindergarten.



APPLICATION & REGISTRATION

Please contact the preschool office to schedule a tour of our school with your child. You and your child can see our facility first hand and ask any additional questions. An application may be downloaded from our webpage or picked-up during the tour and submitted with a \$75 application fee. A packet that includes registration forms and other information can be picked up at the school after the application is turned in.

All required registration forms, a copy of your child's birth certificate, and other required documents must be signed, completed, and submitted to the preschool office along with the first month's tuition.

Your child is guaranteed enrollment upon approval of the preschool director after all forms, other documents, and fees have been submitted and processed by the preschool office.

The \$250 annual comprehensive fee is due prior to the first month of enrollment. This fee pays for field trips, a year-book, your child's school and art supplies, and other costs.

All fees are non-refundable, non-transferable, and not applicable towards tuition. All fees are subject to change.

UNIFORMS

School uniforms are required and may be purchased through the preschool office. $\,$

FOOD

We participate in the USDA Child and Adult Care Nutrition Program. Breakfast, lunch, and afternoon snack are provided by Keiki Gourmet to all children enrolled in the program, and is included in the tuition installments.
