


Who God Is and Is Not

In one diagram



This diagram represents what we know about God according to the revelation of God in Jesus Christ. Everything in the circle is who God is not. Who God is is everything outside the circle. The circle itself represents the revelation – the points at which we can understand who God is. When we press any one of these points too far, we move into heresy. If we move too far away, we move away from the revelation and have nothing of any value to say about God. The words on opposite sides of the circle are in tension with each other.
