How can this be? He is God and can do what he pleases.
- The eternal Son is the Creator of the Universe and the Sustainer of the Universe and the End of the Universe. Wherever you look into eternity from our limited perspective in time and space, Christ is there—He is the eternal God. _____ him!
- (1) In his eternal deity, the Son has always been _____. As God, the Son always possesses “the name.” He is the eternally begotten Son. He is superior to the angels, for they are created by the Son.
- (2) By becoming a man, the Son made humanity _____. As man, he thus inherits “the name.” This elevates humanity above the angels, literally turning the world upside down. The incarnation of the Son upends every creaturely hierarchy.
- All of Christianity depends upon this singular truth, once hidden in the eternal plan of God but then revealed in Palestine 2,000 years ago: In Christ Jesus, the eternal Son has become the man who _____ us from our sin and from the grip of Satan and death.
