**Reflection Questions**

• Who is Jesus Christ?

Is he one person? \_\_\_\_\_

Is he truly human? \_\_\_\_\_

Is he truly divine? \_\_\_\_\_

Why did the Son of God become the Son of Man? To save us from our sins.

• The eternal Son of God became the human Son of Man. It is through his \_\_\_\_\_ that he is made “for a little while lower than the angels.” This alludes to his suffering on the cross and to his death.

• What does the book of Hebrews teach about subordination? It says that the world is being subjected to \_\_\_\_\_, and that it will be entirely subordinated to him \_\_\_\_\_.

• The only way these necessary divine moves for our salvation could have come about was if the second Person of the Trinity became truly human in Jesus Christ.
