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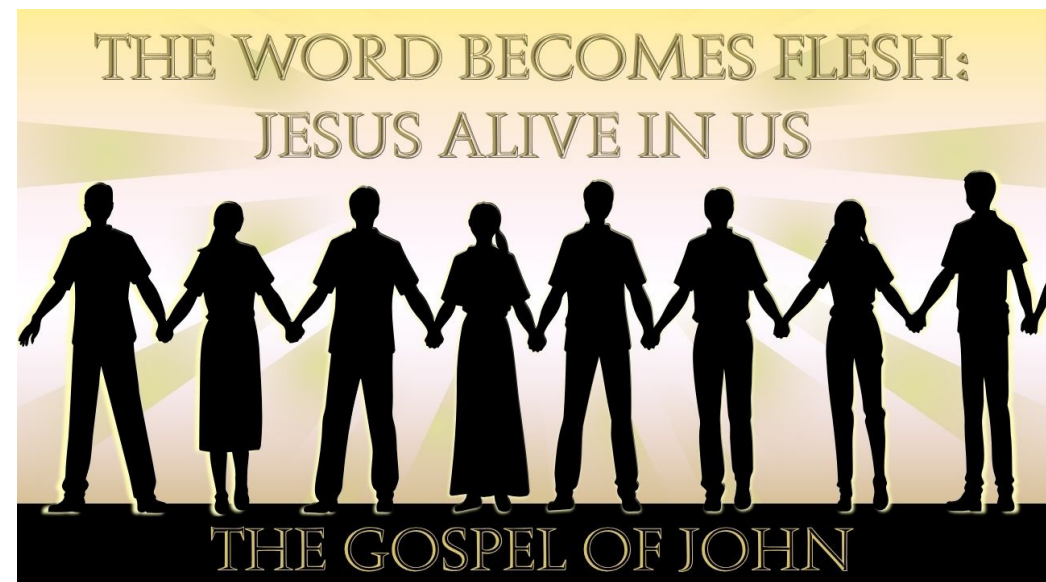

## **Putting Your Faith in Jesus**

John 7:25-36

### **I. Clear the Doubt, Seek the Truth**

- a. The \_\_\_\_\_ we must have in Jesus goes beyond believing in Him as a \_\_\_\_\_ worker, it means believing He is from God and is the \_\_\_\_\_ way to salvation.
